on Saturday 17th November 2012



A Festival Celebration Dinner will be held at the Riviera International Conference Centre at Torquay on Saturday 17th November 2012 to mark the completion of the 2012 Festival for the Royal Masonic Trust for Girls and Boys which the brethren of the Province of Devonshire have supported so wonderfully since it was launched on 2007.

The format of the evening will be a reception, followed by a Festival Dinner, after which there will be a period of entertainment before the toasts and speeches when the final amount raised will be announced by the Chief Executive of the RMTGB. There will also be entertainment during dinner.

The event will be open to all brethren of the Province and they will also be able to bring their ladies or partners. As this is not a Ball we hope that brethren who do not have a wife or partner may wish to attend unaccompanied. The dress code for the evening will be Black Tie, Cocktail Dresses for the Ladies, no regalia, but Festival Jewels will be worn.

The event will be presided over by our Provincial Grand Master R. W. Bro. Michael T Penny and amongst those attending will be one of the Rulers of the Craft, (either the Pro Grand Master, the Deputy Grand Master or Assistant Grand Master), other representatives of Grand Lodge, Officials of the RMTGB and distinguished guests from our sister Provinces.

However, the event is for you, the brethren of this Province to celebrate your achievements and generosity which to date, with over 12 months still to go, has raised almost £3 million for the Festival Appeal. The setting will be round tables for 10 people, and brethren may attend either separately or in groups - please make your wishes known on the application form. Separate cheques for each couple or for individuals can be attached to the booking form. If a form is received on behalf of a couple or an individual they will be able to indicate whom they would like to sit with and we will do our best to accommodate the request. Otherwise we will group people on a lodge basis. The Riviera Centre will also lay on a wine ordering service prior to the dinner.

There is a wide variety of accommodation available in Torquay for those wishing to stay overnight and amongst them is the newly refurbished Belgrave which is now a Premier Inn. Many other hotels are near the Riviera Centre. For those who wish to stay overnight in the Torquay area can book directly with a Hotel if preferred, however we are negotiating discounted terms with Hotels / Guest Houses and details of this will be sent to you with your tickets when sent out, as well as being published on the Festival Web site as soon as full details become available.

Each Lodge Secretary and Charity Steward will have a copy of the booking form which can also be downloaded from the Provincial Web site and the Festival Web Site. Tickets are £39 per head.

We hope that as many brethren as possible will support this event to celebrate our wonderful achievement here in Devon. Please book as early as possible space will be limited even though we have booked one of the largest venues available. Tickets will be sent out early in the New Year.
